## ITINERARY

9.45am Meet Judy by the entrance to platform 4 **London Waterloo mainline station** (not Waterloo East!) *From your homestays, catch the eastbound **Metropolitan Line**, change onto the southbound **Jubilee Line** at Baker Street and alight at Waterloo. Walk up the escalators to the main station.*

**Because Hampton Court Palace is located in Zone 6, your student Oyster cards are valid both there and back so no need for rail tickets! :-)**

10.06am Catch the 1006 train from Waterloo to Hampton Court, reaching destination at 1042 (direct trains leave at 06 and 36 minutes past the hour from Waterloo)

10.45am Short walk to Hampton Court Palace (see map); explore the site. Your tickets grant you access to the palace and gardens, but not the maze.

Trains back to London leave Hampton Court station at 24 and 54 minutes past the hour.
